

## **2016-2018 : Appui à l'ANSD pour la mise en œuvre des EDS continues et des Enquêtes Continues sur la Prestation des Services de Soins de Santé**

### **Main Objectives**

The Senegal Continuous Surveys began in 2012 and will conduct the fourth phase of the **Continuous Survey (CS)** Senegal in 2017. The survey is implemented by the Agence Nationale de la Statistique et la Démographie (ANSD) and the Ministry of Health (MoH). As the subcontractor, the Centre de Recherche pour le Développement Humain (CRDH), will provide additional support in the implementation and monitoring of the CS in Senegal, specifically, to identify areas for improvement and expansion of the use of CS (both DHS and SPA) data in national programming. CRDH will collaborate with ANSD and MoH to strengthen their capacities.

### **CRDH will be responsible for the following activities and deliverables:**

1. Contribute to increase relevance of the Continuous Survey data and improving communication between partners.
  - a) Ensure that ANSD is effectively communicating with MoH and other partners.
  - b) Be a liaison between USAID and ICF throughout the survey operations.
  - c) Identify communication gaps in the dissemination of the survey's results and contribute to an expanded utilization of CS data for programming.
  - d) Participate in Steering Committee Meetings.
2. Contribute to increase relevance and use of the Continuous Survey data.
  - a) Conduct meetings with different data users on the usefulness of the CS data for their respective programs.
  - b) Contribute to strengthening capacities of different Ministry of Health (MoH) programs through meetings and coaching that help to create a group of users that will advocate for the continuity beyond 2017 of the Continuous Survey.
3. Provide technical support to ANSD in the implementation of the survey.
  - a) Assist in the development of surveys instruments (questionnaires, survey and biomarker manuals).
  - b) Assist in training of field staff.
  - c) Conduct 6-7 supervision visits to the fieldwork teams during data collection and provide guidance for improving data quality.
  - d) Provide assistance in the development of tabulation and analysis plan.
  - e) Assist in the preparation/revision survey reports (KIR, Main Reports, others).
4. Provide support in monitoring the survey
  - Assist ANSD in the implementation of the monitoring tool; including the follow-up of the capacity strengthening plan.
  - Through field check tables, monitor the quality of the data and guide ANSD in identifying gaps and weak areas during data collection.
  - Send to ICF and ANSD a report of field check tables with recommendations for improving data quality.

Monitor the implementation of the survey operation as stated in the protocol on behalf of ICF.
